EPA 228-366 RAZOR Pro Herbicide Call a poison control center - Medical emergencies only call 877-325-1840

IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a poison control. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow, do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center, do not give anything by mouth if unconscious

IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air. If not breathing, call 911, then give mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call poison control center.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off the contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call poison control center.

IF IN EYES – Hold eyes open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 -20 minutes, remove contacts

Pesticide(s) product-label instructions and precautions related to Public Safety: Causes moderate eye irritation, harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Do not get in eyes or on clothing Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist.
